Grading Policy

30% - Classwork and formative assessments

 This category includes assignments, attendance, workdays, time-on-task in class and overall effort in the program.

70% - Projects and *summative assessments

- This category includes the actual making of the product for our school either the news show or the yearbook: Writing, video/photography, design, editor duties, leadership, etc.
- Grades are earned through producing quality work, even if you have to make revisions to get there.
